## Instructions

1. Fixtures/Products must be installed and operational prior to application submission.
2. Proof of installation must accompany this application. Proof may take the form of an invoice from a certified contractor or a photo of the product after installation.
3. A copy of the sales receipt or invoice must accompany this application. Receipts/invoices must include the make and model of the products(s) purchased.
4. Some rebates require additional forms or proof of purchase/installation to qualify. See 'Rebate Requirements' chart for details.
5. Tenants must submit an owner-authorized letter.

## Terms and Limitations:

1. Gallatin River Task Force staff or agents may contact applicant by phone or in writing to verify information provided for in the application.
2. Only residences within the Big Sky Resort Tax Area District are eligible to participate in the Big Sky Water Conservation Program and receive any rebates.
3. The rebate amounts are applicable only to fixtures that fit the required certification outlined in the tables on the next page.
4. Old products cannot be reused; applicants agree to destroy or disable their old products.
5. Installation of products is the sole responsibility of the applicant.
6. The products must be installed at the installation address listed.
7. The effective date of the Big Sky Water Conservation Program is July 1, 2016. Rebates for products installed prior to July 1, 2016 will not be given. Rebate amounts and eligible products are subject to change at any time.
8. Applications will be processed in the order they are received.
9. Incomplete applications could be denied and returned to applicant or result in a delay of rebate approval
10. Limited funding is available to issue rebates. Rebates will be issued on a first-come, first-serve basis, subject to funding availability.
11. A rebate check will be mailed within 6-8 weeks of receipt provided the application is complete and funding is available.
12. Rebate amount is not to exceed purchase price. In this instance, the rebate amount will be lowered to the purchase price

## Rebate Requirements (please read carefully to ensure that application includes all necessary documents)

Irrigation Audit	1. Include Irrigation Audit Form signed by landscape professional
Smart Controllers	1. Must be EPA WaterSense labeled
Sprinkler Spray Bodies	1. Must purchase a minimum of 5 2. Must be EPA WaterSense labeled
Drip Irrigation	1. Must be purchased from list of approved products 2. Submit photos of installed and operational equipment.
Turf Conversion	1. Must convert a minimum of 100 square feet. 2. The area must be replaced with one of or a combination of: native vegetation such as grasses, flowers, shrubs, and trees, permeable hard-surface such as cobblestone. 3. <b>Must schedule a site visit prior to turf conversion. See website for details.</b>
