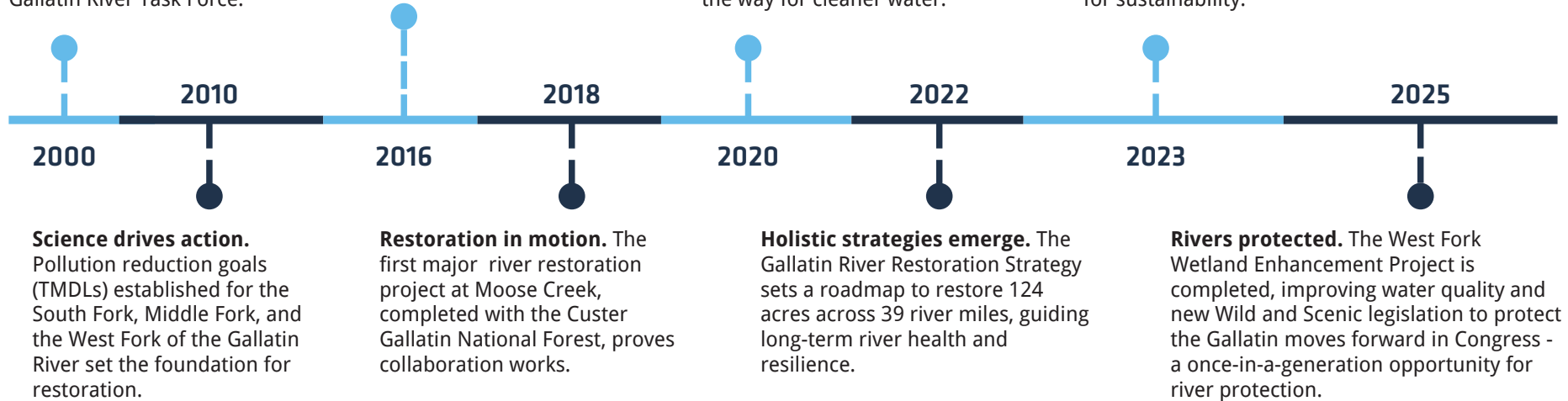


Our story begins. Established under Montana State University as the Blue Water Task Force, we started monitoring water quality to protect the Gallatin—later becoming the Gallatin River Task Force.

Conservation at home. The Big Sky Water Conservation Program begins, helping our community use water wisely.

Infrastructure for clean water. Task Force data and advocacy led to the formation of the Gallatin Canyon Water and Sewer District and voter approved funding for new wastewater facilities, paving the way for cleaner water.

Partnerships deepen. With Montana DEQ, we launched a major algae monitoring effort, and building on a pilot study led by the Task Force, the Yellowstone Club became the first ski resort in Montana to use recycled water for snowmaking - a major milestone for sustainability.
